**I. MINUTES**

#### A. Revisions to Architect Regulations K.A.R. 66-9-7, K.A.R. 66-10-1, K.A.R. 66-10-3

Mr. Wimmer relayed that all regulations have received final approval from the Attorney General's office. The Committee scheduled the Public Hearing to be held during the Board meeting on April 26, 2019. A Notice of Hearing will be published in the Kansas Register to announce the date to the public.

##### 1. ASBOG – Updates – Henthorne

Mr. Henthorne reported he recently traveled to Florida for the annual ASBOG meeting. Mr. Henthorne reported he received the National Sherman award for excellent service to ASBOG while there. He relayed that the sunset review on Texas has been tabled and will be reviewed again in five years. Mr. Henthorne reported that the newest state to go through a sunset review is Florida. He will continue to monitor.

##### 2. CLARB – Updates – McMullen

Ms. McMullen reported she recently traveled to CLARB's annual meeting in Canada where she gave a presentation on updating bi-laws. The adoption of the new bi-laws failed by one vote. Ms. McMullen reported that the Board of Directors are planning to present the same presentation next year in hopes of a better outcome. Ms. McMullen reported the L.A.R.E. exams recently underwent a friction analysis during which licensed members were able to see the new exam questions and hear from a current landscape architecture student. Ms. McMullen reported CLARB's new President is Phil Meyer.

##### 3. NCARB – Updates – Johnson/Wimmer

###### i. CE Guidelines Comment Period

Mr. Johnson reported NCARB is looking for comments to their updated Continuing Education guidelines. Mr. Wimmer requested that all members of the committee review the new guidelines and prepare questions and comments by the February 15, 2019 committee meeting.
