I. MINUTES

II. APPLICATIONS

A. Discussion of applications not approved by letter ballot

1. Ballot 17-115 Architect License by Reciprocity - Mancini

a. Lindsey Rayburn – Discipline

By motion of Mr. Mancini, seconded by Mr. Hoffman, the Committee voted to approve the application for Architect License by Reciprocity.

III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Revisions to Architect Regulations K.A.R. 66-9-7, K.A.R. 66-10-1, K.A.R. 66-10-3

The Committee discussed progress on each regulation and reviewed the proposed policies submitted by Executive Director Ms. Lopez. By motion of Mr. Hoffman, seconded by Ms. McMullen, the Committee voted to approve all revisions made to K.A.R. 66-9-7, 66-10-1 and 66-10-3.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. Society updates/reports of national meetings or committees/discussion of national issues

1. ASBOG – Updates – Henthorne

Mr. Henthorne reported his presence at the Council of Examiners meeting held in early April as well as an increase in attendance for the Fundamentals of Geology and Practice of Geology exams.

2. CLARB – Updates – McMullen

Ms. McMullen reported that she has been nominated to serve on the Committee of Nominations for CLARB and is currently in the interview process for final selection. Final selection will be announced this coming September at the annual CLARB meeting in Boise, Idaho. Ms. McMullen plans to be in attendance at this annual meeting.

3. NCARB – Updates – Hoffman

Mr. Hoffman reported that Wichita, KS has been selected for regional and MBE NCARB meetings on March 9-10, 2018; Planning is already underway. Mr. Hoffman currently serves as Chair on NCARB's Centennial Committee and reports there is to be a centennial celebration planned in 2019 to take place in Washington D.C. Mr. Hoffman plans to join forces with Executive Director Shelby Lopez to create a presentation/booklet from KSBTP for the centennial celebration. Mr. Hoffman also shared that ARE 5.0 cut scores have been set and the IPAL program is expanding as additional schools are showing interest. There has been no resolution set for the upcoming NCARB meeting in June regarding regulatory boards that have not made their dues.

4. New Program Degree Proposal- Bachelor of Science in Interior Architecture and Design

The Committee reviewed University of Kansas' proposal to the Board of Regents in which the term "Interior Architect" is used. The Committee suggests Ms. Lopez draft a letter on behalf of the Board to the University of Kansas with the purpose of conveying that the title of "Architect" is protected; No formal action.
